UKRAINE EMERGENCY

WHAT TO DO ON ARRIVAL IN TOWN

Initial information for those who have arrived from Ukraine or are hosting Ukrainian refugees in Cinisello Balsamo:

1. Go as soon as possible and preferably **within 5 days** of your arrival to the **UNIQUE ACCESS POINT** (PUA) in via Terenghi, 2 – from Monday to Friday from 8 am to 4 pm

to do health screening, SARS-CoV-2 tampons and registration on the Health Service/ with the issue of STP (Temporarily Present Foreigner).

- 2. Appear within 8 days before the police headquarters
